VTLA's work is informed and inspired by site, ecology, hydrology, heritage, and horticultural possibilities. Engaging with land as a social, artistic and curatorial practice, VTLA brings client's vision to life by integrating broad, conceptual thinking with detailed design, 3-D visual representations, and technical drawing; pushing beyond superficial, aesthetic gestures to offer layers of delight and beauty through the use of place-appropriate materials and forms that enhance life for all.

Victoria practices as an explorer, investigator, grower, builder, and experimenter, combining artistic expression, natural systems enhancement, with functionality, public safety and infrastructural enhancement. Using the materials of the trade - soil, stone, steel, wood, plants, water, concrete, and light - her work dives deep to reveal new and hidden potentials to re-awaken each site for life.
